The Corporation of the TOWNSHIP OF THE ARCHIPELAGO BY-LAW NO. 15-31

Being a By-law to regulate Transportation Systems, Parking and Public Parks within the Corporation of the Township of The Archipelago

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001*, c. 25, S.10, provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to regulate certain public docks and parks within the Township of The Archipelago;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a By-law of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of The Archipelago, enacts as follows:

- **1.** Definitions:
 - a) Public Parks for the purposes of this By-law include the facilities, ice rinks, land, buildings, waterfront areas, walkways, docks, wharfs and equipment owned, leased or under the control of the Township of The Archipelago which are outlined on Schedule "A".
- 2. No person shall park any vehicle, trailer or any other thing in any park owned by the Corporation of the Township of The Archipelago except in areas specifically marked for this purpose.
- **3.** No person shall leave any boat, vehicle or trailer at any municipal dock for more than the permitted time.
- 4. No person shall use any municipal park for any purpose other than those permitted by the municipality.
- 5. The use of Public Parks is subject to the conditions, fees and fines which are outlined on Schedule "B".
- 6. Any person contravening any section of this By-law is guilty of an offence, and shall upon conviction thereof, be liable to a fine not exceeding \$5,000.00. Every such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
- 7. That By-law No. 15-16 is hereby repealed; and
- 8. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.

READ and **FINALLY PASSED** in **OPEN COUNCIL** this 14th day of August, 2015.

Schedule "B"

1. <u>Fees for Use of Dock/Wharf</u>:

a) Usage of Dock/Wharf:

All docking fees come into effect the Friday before the Victoria Day long weekend and continue until the Wednesday following Labour Day.

- Rates for overnight docking are 0.55 cents per foot or \$1.70 per metre of boat length. Overnight users must depart by 10:00 am the next morning.

b) Usage of Loading Area on Wharf:

A seasonal permit of \$500.00 **must be** purchased by all <u>commercial users</u> of the wharf which allows seasonal use of the wharf. Materials may only remain in the designated area for a period of 24 hours. An additional \$150.00 shall be charged per day if materials remain in the designated area for longer than 24 hours.

An alternative weekly fee of \$100.00 (7 consecutive days) is available for <u>non-commercial users (i.e. residents and ratepayers)</u> which allows use of the wharf for a one-week period. Materials may only remain in the designated area for a period of 24-hours. An additional \$150.00 shall be charged per day if materials remain in the designated area for longer than 24 hours.

A one-day \$25.00 user fee is available for <u>non-commercial users</u> (<u>i.e. residents and ratepayers</u>). Materials may only remain in the designated area for a period of 24 hours. An additional \$150.00 shall be charged per day if materials remain in the designated area for longer than 24-hours.

The use of a trailer or equipment for the movement of goods has a two-hour limit, and is subject to a \$10.00 per hour fee after two hours.

c) Pumpout Fees:

Sewage pumpout fee is \$25.00 per boat.

d) Vehicle Parking:

Vehicles are permitted to load/unload in the identified area along the wharf provided the vehicle is attended. Loading/unloading is limited to a maximum of 20 minutes.

2. Fees for use of Buildings/Land/Parks/Waterfront Areas:

3. <u>Fines:</u>

Boats that exceed the two-hour permit time shall be secured by chain to the dock. A \$75.00 charge shall be applied to the owner/user and must be paid before the chain is removed.

Vehicles found parked unattended in the Loading Zone will be towed and impounded. All costs are to be borne by the owner/operator of the vehicles.
